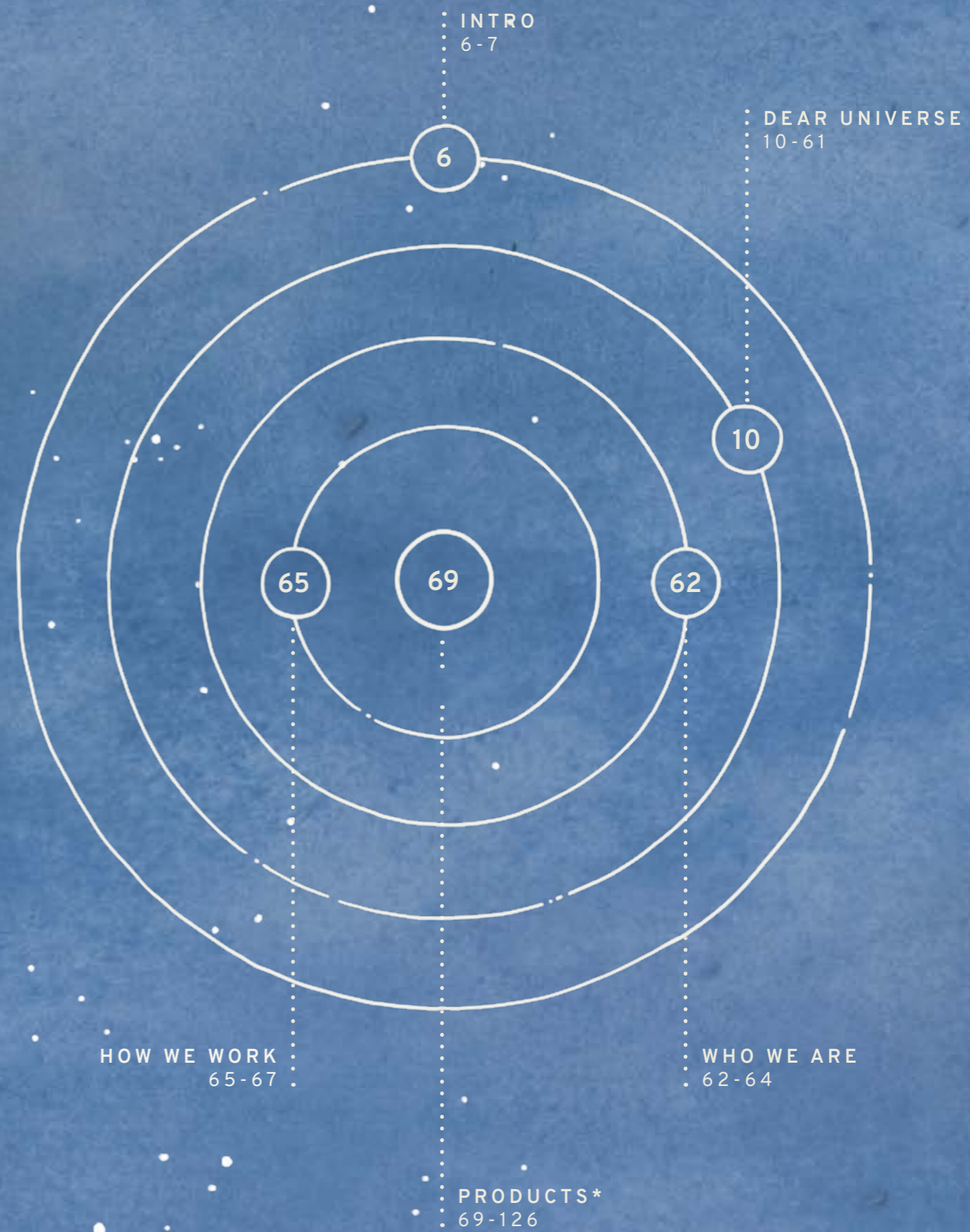

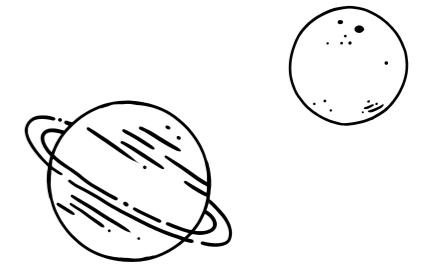
Dear Universe,
What is the correct amount of gas for a perfect sun? How long should the tail of a comet be? Must my planet have an atmosphere? Maybe rings? How many moons?... What is correct? What are the rules? "Don't you know?" says Universe. "Can't you see? There are none. They are all unique and different... Let them be."

We wish kids were stellar objects who spin and sway, seeking balance to find an orbit of their own that integrates them into the system. But they are not. At the very moment a kid is born, this kid becomes a daughter or a son, a sibling, a grandchild, a neighbour, a playmate... From that moment this kid has not only inherited their parents' traits but also their culture, their knowledge... their hopes, their expectations... their rules, their norms. We have a right amount of energy the perfect child should have, an exact

length for a boy's hair, a desirable posture for a gentle girl. Kids cannot spin and sway seeking for their own orbit... kids are educated and taught and pushed into the orbit we draw, and we expect them to rotate at the imposed tempo. But it would be useless for Saturn to try to rotate the same way as Mars, because they're not the same.

Kids try and try to fit our expectations because they need to feel loved and to be included. "I love you for who you are," we say. And that's exactly what they understand... I'm clever, I'm witty, I'm brave and loyal, and a dreamer and a thinker, I'm obedient, clean and quiet... I'm enough. But I'm also naughty and restless, curious and distracted, one of those "all by myself" kids that runs without shelter in the rain... and then I'm not. Kids must be loved for the sake of being and they should be part because they are part of us. And this





way it doesn't matter if Venus rotates in the opposite direction or if Uranus orbits lying face up in the sky. We would like to have kids grow up having their feet on the ground... with their own gravity, because they have their own density, probably a different heat and even some unknown elements that nourish them from the roots to the wings. But we try to walk on their surface like on ours, without changing our boots, although you need bare feet among the dense clouds of Jupiter and perhaps a heavy pair so you don't float away on the Moon. Kids try and try to define themselves and to create their own identity. And they should have the right to outline their own surfaces, drawing and forming their landscapes as their cores need. You could sharpen or round the edges, the same way a stellar wind would do, but you can't give them a different shape without breaking and cratering them like a meteorite would do.

We want kids to be explored instead of colonised. They are not empty spaces waiting to be filled with bright stars. They are already a deep sky full of lights. Sometimes you need to dig a lot of holes to reach an unimaginable ability that boils enthusiastically beneath the

surface of cold rocks. Sometimes you only need to wait patiently, to pay attention and put aside expectations... 'cause you will never be able to see Neptune's diamond rain if you cover up yourself for fear of getting wet.


Kids are unique planets that run and run around the Sun. Except for those that are not. You can try to make them round, you can try to smooth their orbit, you can try to erase or cover or mask their tail. Some kids are unique comets that zip around the Sun in their elliptical way. Close they come and far they go beyond the asteroid belt that defines our system. They will go in one end and out another, grazing the stars we cannot reach. They sense the universe in a way we cannot understand or share, but we can help them to pass by the Sun carefully so they don't lose their tails. We would like all kids to be seen as "starflakes": unique, wonderful and rare. Stardust that comes together to create THEM.



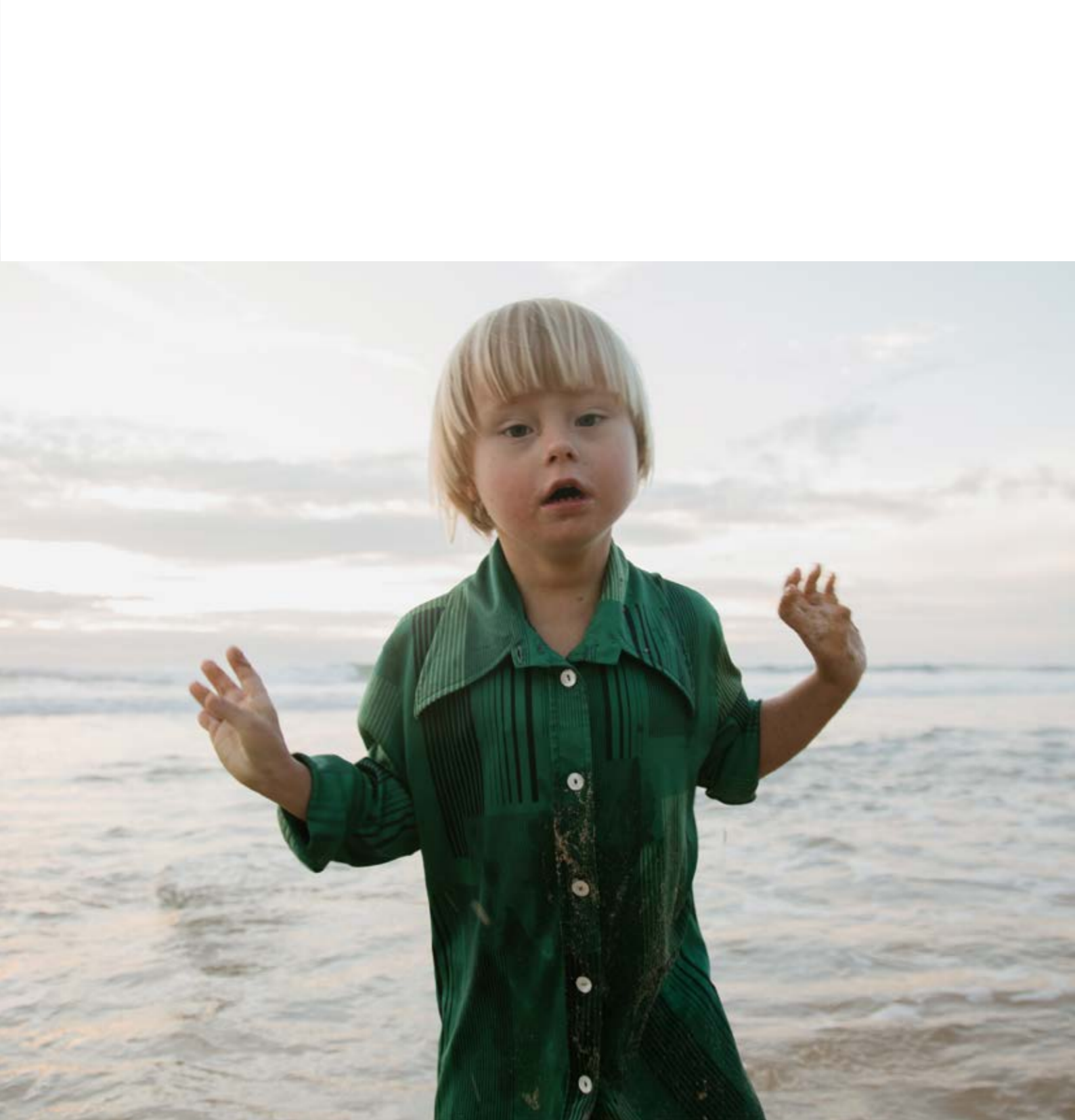

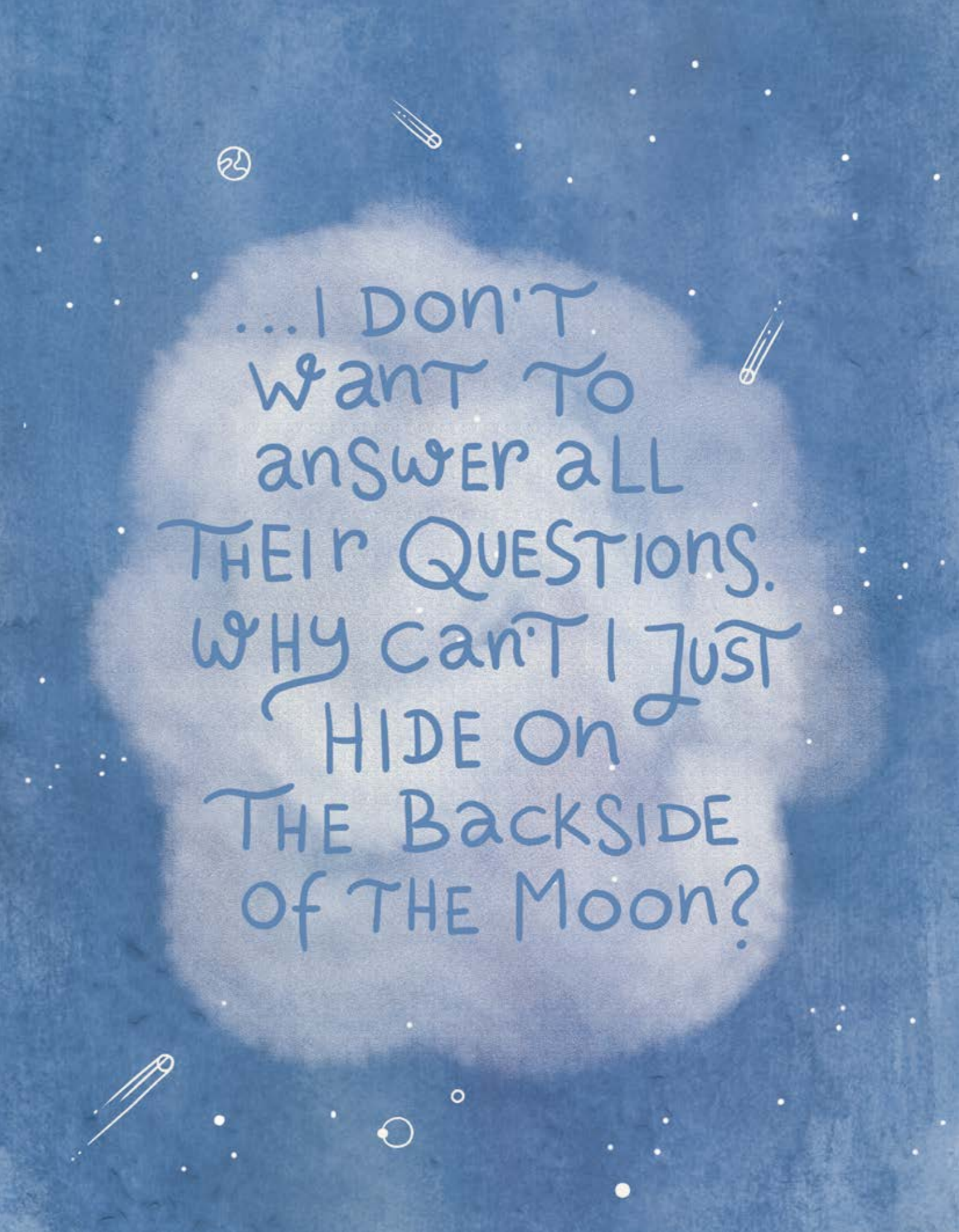










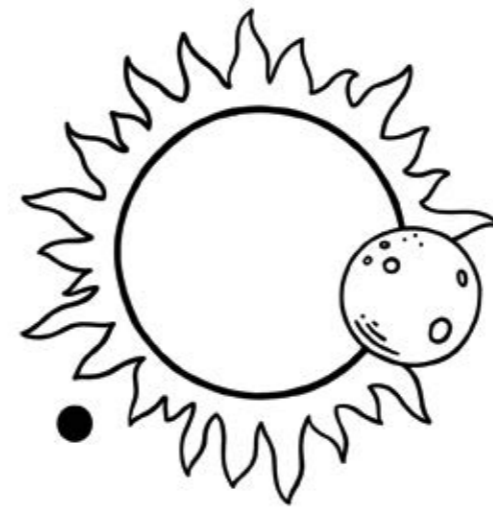

WHO
WE are

Grapat started to form as an idea after the birth of our first “starflake” Lola. She was an ingenious and resourceful kid who built her own play universe with everyday objects that became whatever she desired. She didn’t really need any off-the-shelf toys in order to play, she was happy with a few real things, her imagination and, above everything, our presence. We realised there was no need to buy and consume, but to observe, give space and live consciously.

After the birth of our second “starflake” Tomàs, we decided we needed a new orbit, away from the city belt, where we could rotate into a slower way of life we had been longing for. Living in the countryside allowed us to connect to ourselves, and living without the imposed tempo with our two children let us discover a true passion for transmitting this notion of freedom and openness into children’s playtime, which our kids had experienced. Our wish was to offer a new kind of toys, far from the ordinary types, that would do good for kids, parents, planet and the whole ecosystem we live in, that could have a long-lasting impact on our society and the future adults of tomorrow.



That way we started to play and create with wood, and slowly the family home turned into a full operational workshop where we created the pieces with machinery installed in the barn and dyed them by hand with old sheets in the kitchen. This is when Grapat finally materialised, because Grapat –“a handful” in Catalan, the native language of our land– is a humble comet that carries a handful of loose pieces with the utmost care in our hands. No matter how Grapat has grown since then, spreading globally over 62 countries, and no matter how many more and more production space we need, we still create new pieces and prototypes out of clay or beeswax, we

keep staining our pieces by hand in-house and we still communicate with the universe using our authentic voice. Grapat found its orbit spinning and swaying around our way of live and our vision for the future we believe, and is, and always will be, a family project. We know well what boundaries we need to respect, as overcoming them in order to grow quicker would simply not be who we are. We believe in an organic growth that happens inevitably but consciously, at a sustainable rhythm.

Nature is both our clock and our muse. We live in rhythm with her, respecting her, and she is our design inspiration for every new



piece we create. Our true, main inspiration though, is children. With Grapat, we want to make sure that every child has a free and respectful upbringing, filled with open-ended playtimes that should invite and incite their own genuine flair for creation without instructions nor limits. Our duty as parents is protected this sacred moment, put aside expectations and let them outline their own universe to grow, learn and find themselves. Our motto is "be free, play open!" Every time a box leaves the factory, we think about how the children will share the best playtimes with our pieces, with the intention that they will last forever. Our aim is timeless: if our material gets passed on from one generation to another, then it means our purpose will have been fulfilled, and this is our hope and joy.



We work at the service of childhood, offering open play material, loose parts and kits that favour open-ended play and lets the child connect with their inner desires, their inner selves, to find their own path. We don't want to simply offer material, we feel like we have a social responsibility towards society, and our true wish is to spread knowledge and practical ways of integrating valuable pedagogy that resonates with this philosophy of freedom into our everyday lives.

We are in a lifelong love affair with Nature, we accept that we lack control over her so we simply observe and respect her. Our creations are an offering to her, not an attempt to modify her laws. Our goal is simplicity itself - when working on a product, we draw inspiration from its true natural form and then try to reduce it to the essential, detaching from the unnecessary, resorting to as little material as possible. This is because the less information a toy has, the more a child can build upon it, and transform the piece from playtime to playtime with their pure ingeniousness.

Wood is our element. It is warm and alive, it is soft and robust at the same time. Its irregular shapes and incomplete patterns make it unique and truly beautiful to our eyes. Its texture holds a wealth of information and hidden stories waiting to be discovered by the senses of every child. Over time, the wood will acquire subtle dents and scars, and that means that it has accomplished its very aim, providing children with hours and hours of free and open-ended play, and we deeply cherish

that. The "imperfectness" of the wood makes each piece unique - just like us humans!

Our toys are produced according to traditional manufacturing processes and with locally-sourced sustainable materials.

Colour has the power to connect us to emotions and to everything that happens inside of us, this is why our colours come directly from nature and reconnect us to her. Each piece is stained by hand; working with dyes instead of acrylic paint allows us to keep in contact with the wood and its veins in a kind and noble way. The dye sinks deep into the surface of the wood without covering its beauty and giving an everlasting effect.

Depending on temperature, humidity and wind, the dye gets absorbed into the surface of the wood in different ways, but we appreciate this as it is another seal of authenticity and truthfulness.

Due to the excess of pigment, some pieces might lose colour when getting in touch

with saliva, but this is absolutely fine as all colours are 100% safe and non-toxic. The elements are finished using waxes and oils of vegetable origin. The oils can have a strong aroma at first, but they soften with time. Enjoy it while it lasts!

As part of our engagement to sustainability, our packaging has been 100% free of plastic since 2019. We use cardboard boxes for all our products to contribute to the reduction of waste on the planet. We actually encourage the reuse of the packaging itself, as it can become an integral part of the play. We are also continually making changes and improvements towards this direction in all of our production and shipping processes, sharing every step in total transparency through our social media platforms.

Social responsibility is part of our way of life, so we collaborate with foundations that take care of people with physical or mental disabilities who help us to develop packaging tasks. We are also active in giving back to society by supporting different charities and humanitarian projects with a focus on childhood and families..

When forming the company, we didn't want to use a traditional business model. We don't believe in pyramidal structures so we shaped it according to a sociocratic philosophy. We practice self-management and shared authority. Family conciliation with work is a topic that we take special care of, so the working schedule of each employee is adapted to everyone's personal needs. Happy work is better work! ••





CERTIFICATIONS



The dyes are water based and non toxic. The colours and their appearance might vary slightly, like nature itself.



The wood we use comes from sustainable forests and holds the certification PEFC 14-35-00485.



The finishes are made with wax and oils of vegetable origin.



Some of our products include cotton bags. All the fabrics have a GOTS Certificate (Global Organic Textile Standard) as they are produced ecologically and with social responsibility.



All of our collaborators and suppliers are of proximity, located in Europe. In this way we can know about the way of working and can ensure fair working conditions.



The workshop is structured according to the TEAL philosophy. It's based on self-management, fulfilment and personal growth.



All our packaging is 100% plastic free. We also produce the boxes with a heavy-weight cardboard that ensures the life of the box for approximately 5 years. We consider our boxes as part of the toy.



Most of our products are in one piece. In spite of this, some elements need the use of glue for their assembly. The glue used is 100% formaldehyde free.



All our products are manufactured and tested in accordance with the safety requirements of the European (EN71 1-2-3), American (ASTM) Toy Safety Standards, and ISO8124.





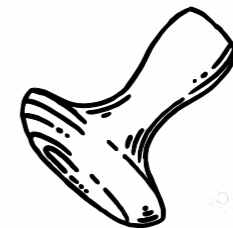
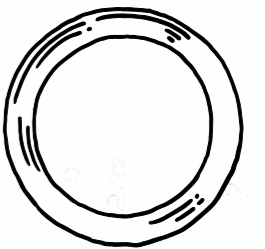
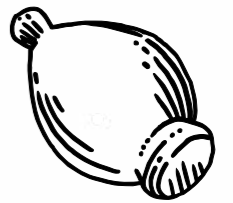

Our proposal for the playsets favours creative and divergent thinking. Free play allows our children to connect with their deepest desire and develop the activity they need.

Our materials are open to allow children to navigate themselves through all their learning phases. The pieces can be transformed into symbolic material for the creation of stories and the construction of small worlds, but can also lend themselves for mathematical, language or sensory play activities.

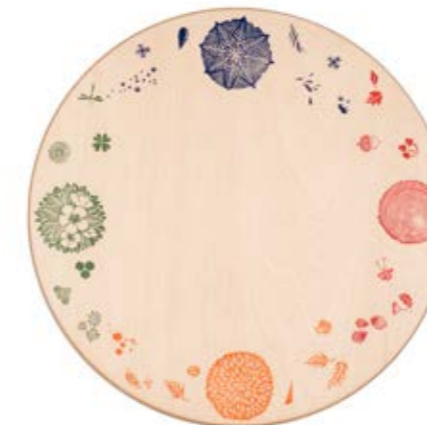

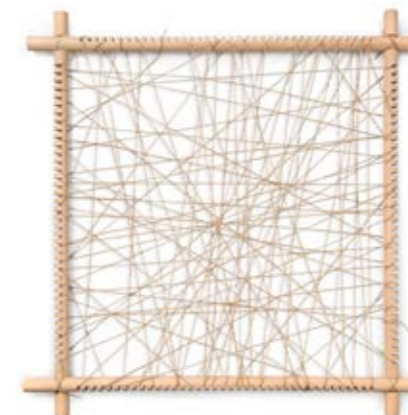

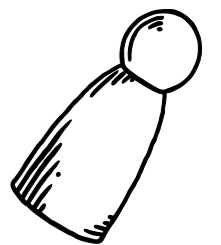
Our collection of loose parts is intended as a complement to the sets, although the pieces can also be used separately.

The loose parts allow children to redesign and reformulate. They can also be combined with objects found outside to favour contact with our closest environment.

Loose parts can be used for multiple purposes. There is no single specific way to use them and there is no right or wrong way to play with them.

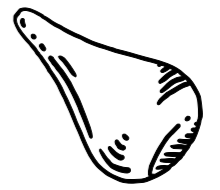

When the kids grow and get to the phase of concrete learning, Mandala pieces can be of help with counting, lining up, or creating letters ... just let them surprise you!

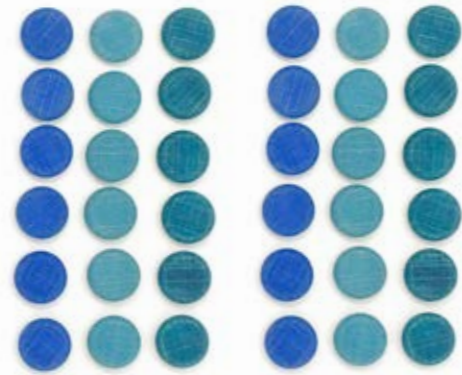
